RE: Request by FRESHFARM Markets to DDOT for the use of public space and metered parking for the 2014 Foggy Bottom Market

Dear Mr. Godin,

At its regular meeting on February 19, 2014, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A ("ANC 2A" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With all eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (8-0):

ANC 2A supports the request by the applicant to reserve the use of 11 metered parking spaces on the 916-999 block of New Hampshire Avenue, N.W. during the 2014 farmers market season. Additionally, the Commission does not object to the applicant's request for usage of 300 square feet of sidewalk space at the intersection of 23<sup>rd</sup> and I Streets, N.W.

The Commission requests, however, that the applicant be vigilant in ensuring that market vendors and patrons do not park in a manner that obstructs the driveways of residences on the 900 block of New Hampshire Avenue. Otherwise, ANC 2A is appreciative of the market's significant, positive annual contribution to the quality of life in the Foggy Bottom and West End neighborhoods.
