Dear Chairperson Marcou,

At its regular meeting on April 16, 2014, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A (“ANC 2A” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. With seven of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted to approve the following resolution by a vote of (6-0-0)ⁱ:

ANC 2A has no objection to this public space application, however the Commission respectfully requests that the Public Space Committee take steps to ensure that the ANC is properly served with notice of pending applications from within its boundaries. In this and other recent cases, adequate notice was not provided to the Commission, hindering its ability to effectively represent the interests of community residents in matters of public space regulation.
