Dear Chair Pfaehler,

At its regular meeting on October 15, 2014, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A ("**ANC 2A**" or "**Commission**") considered the above-referenced matter. With five of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following resolution by a vote of (4-0-1):

ANC 2A supports the Application as it has been presented, contingent upon the Applicant conducting a flag test to demonstrate that the rear addition shall not be visible from Eye Street.

ANC 2A further encourages the Applicant to continue a dialogue with the adjoining property owner and attempt to address any issues specifically related to historic preservation that the property owner may have about the addition.
