At its regular meeting on January 17, 2024, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A ("ANC 2A" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With five of eight commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission, after a motion made by Commissioner Patel and seconded by Commissioner Bandy, adopted the following resolution by unanimous consent:

ANC 2A protests Bodega Taqueria y Tequila's application for a new Retailer's Class "C" Tavern license at 2127 I Street NW based on the adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood. The ANC agrees to withdraw the protest if and when a satisfactory settlement agreement is signed by the ANC and the applicant.
