Re: Letter of Support for Proposed Extended Work Hours for 1957 E Street City View and State Room Project, George Washington University

Dear Members of the Commission,

As Commissioner for Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2A, I am writing to express my strong support for the extended hours application submitted by The George Washington University (GW) for construction work at the 1957 E Street City View and State Room Project.

I understand that the proposed permit would allow the university to conduct work on Saturdays and Sundays, with a start time as early as 5:00 a.m., for the period beginning October 24, 2025, through December 19, 2025.

This extension is required to complete critical interior structural elements currently behind schedule, specifically extensive interior welding of metal and steel framing, new steel framing to infill the stairwell, bolt inspections for the structural framing, and window installation at the roof level. I support this request based on GW's significant commitment to mitigating potential community disruptions: All extended work will be strictly limited to the interior (reducing noise and visibility near the active residence hall), no noisy construction will begin before 7:00 a.m., activities will focus on quiet interior finishes to maintain low noise levels, and no truck deliveries scheduled to before 7am.

I appreciate the university's proactive engagement with the community on this matter and its continued efforts to ensure that campus facilities can be completed with minimal neighborhood impact.

I encourage the Commission to approve this proposal and allow the university to move forward with its plan, balancing the need for timely project completion with consideration for the adjacent community.
