ANC 2A received a request regarding a proposed project located at 2529 I Street NW, Washington, DC. The applicants, Michael Schroeder and Amber Wason, have submitted a drawing package to the Historic Preservation Review Board (HPRB) for concept review for our February 2026 regular ANC 2A meeting.

The proposed project involves the addition of a fourth floor to the property. The design intends to closely mimic the existing fourth floor addition at the adjacent property located at 2531 I Street NW, which was constructed in the late 1970s. The goal of the applicants is to maintain architectural consistency with the neighboring structure while expanding their home. Mr. Schroeder and Ms. Wason currently reside in the property with their growing family, which includes two legal bedrooms, one toddler, and two infant twins. The proposed expansion is intended to provide the necessary space to accommodate their five-person household.

As the Chairperson of ANC 2A representing the affected Single Member District, I am writing to express my support for the concept review of this project. This support is given with the understanding that the proposed addition will be designed in a manner consistent with the historic character of the surrounding area and will not negatively impact the quality of life of nearby residents.
