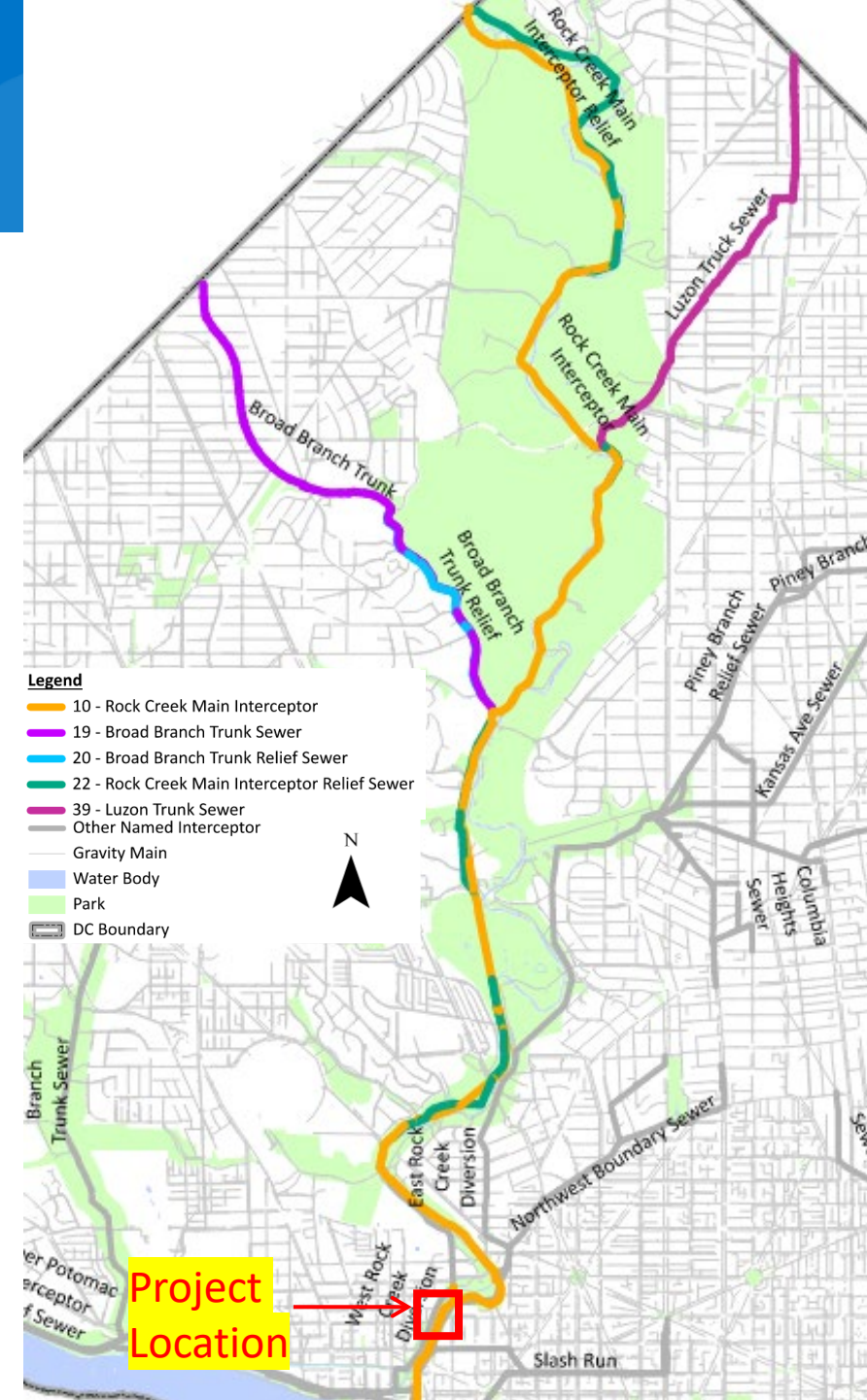
Project Background



Project Background

Rock Creek Main Interceptor (RCMI)

- 100-year-old major sewer line running next to Rock Creek
- Carries 100 million gallons of wastewater a day from the MD/DC border through the District
- Routine inspections identified major structural issues and the need for high-priority repairs
- Why now?** Failure of this interceptor could result in an impact to environmental and public health, including Rock Creek

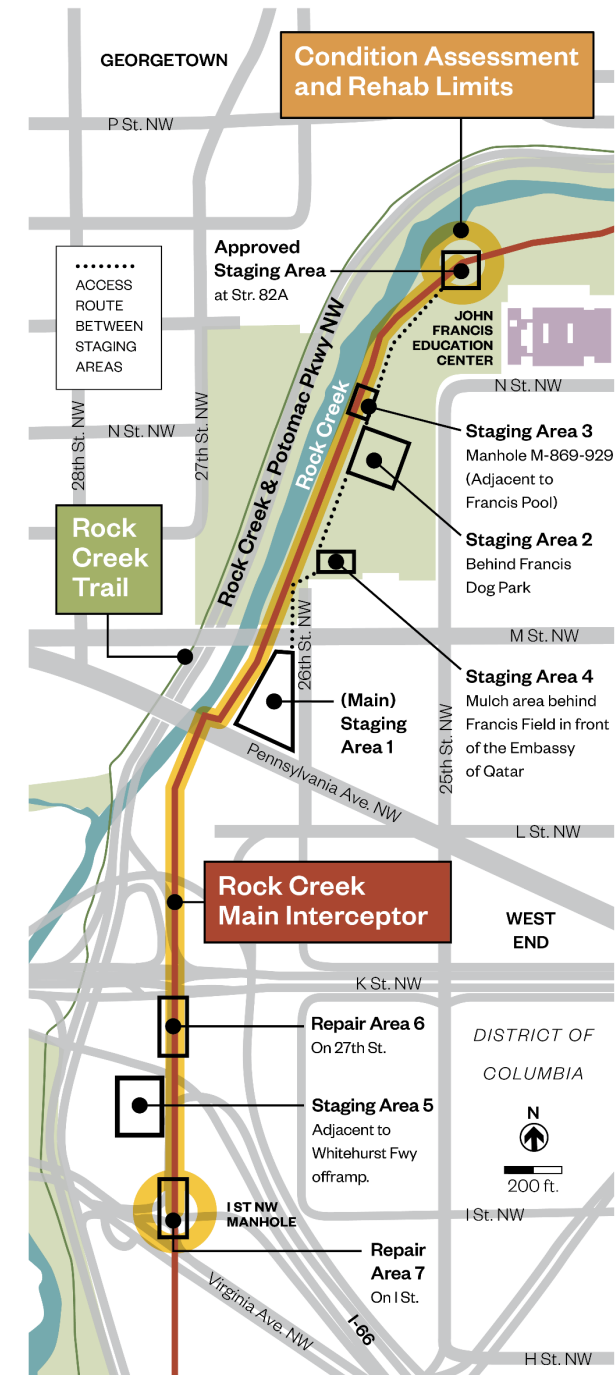
Pipeline Rehabilitation Anticipated Schedule

Activity	Anticipated Schedule*
Structure Repairs and Flow Diversion Preparation	Fall 2025 to Spring 2026
Pipe Preparation and Rehabilitation Design	Spring 2026 to Summer 2026
Mobilization / Staging Area	Early/Mid July 2026 to early August 2026
Pipe Rehabilitation	Summer 2026 to Summer 2027

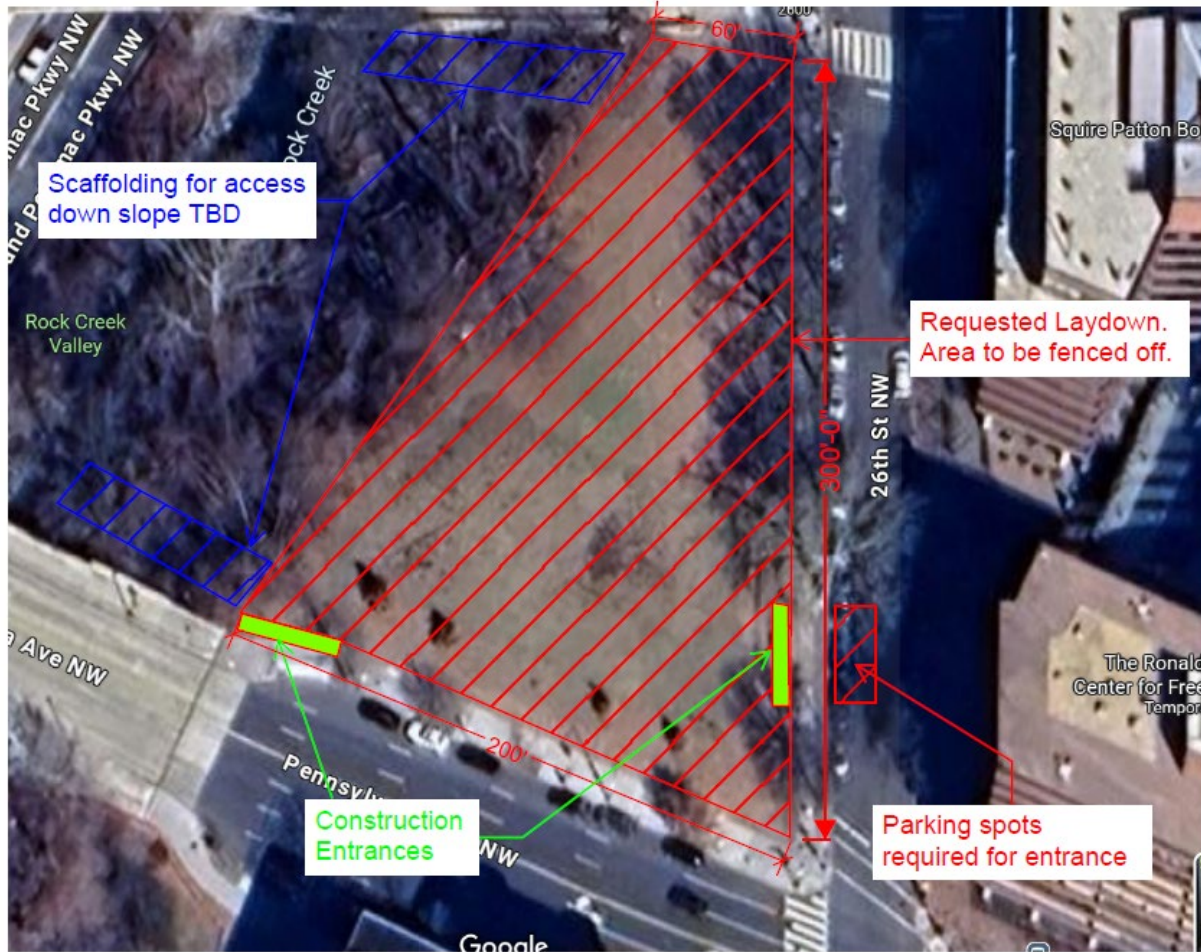

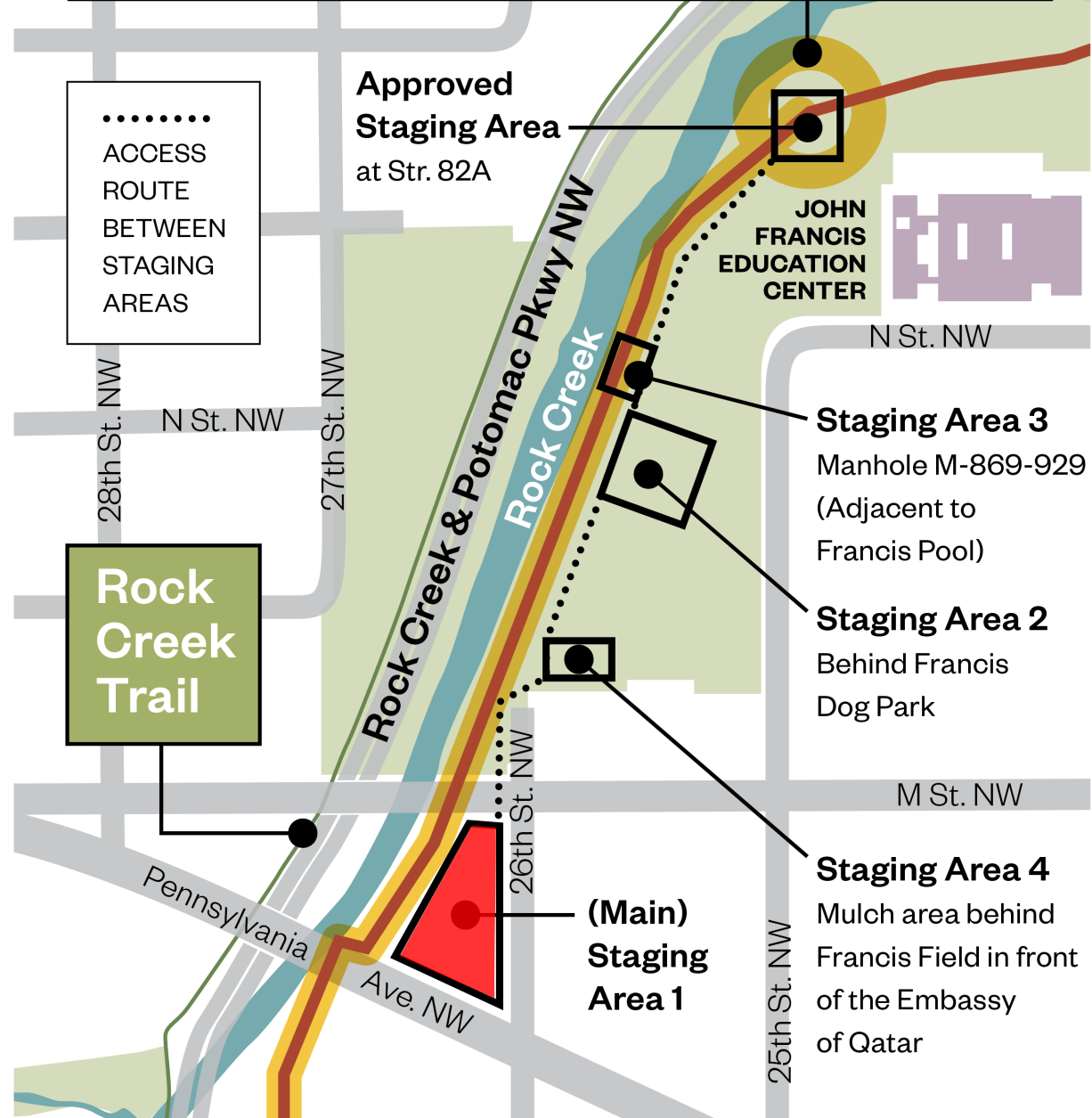
Staging Areas

*Sidewalks should be unaffected unless vehicle is entering/exiting laydown area

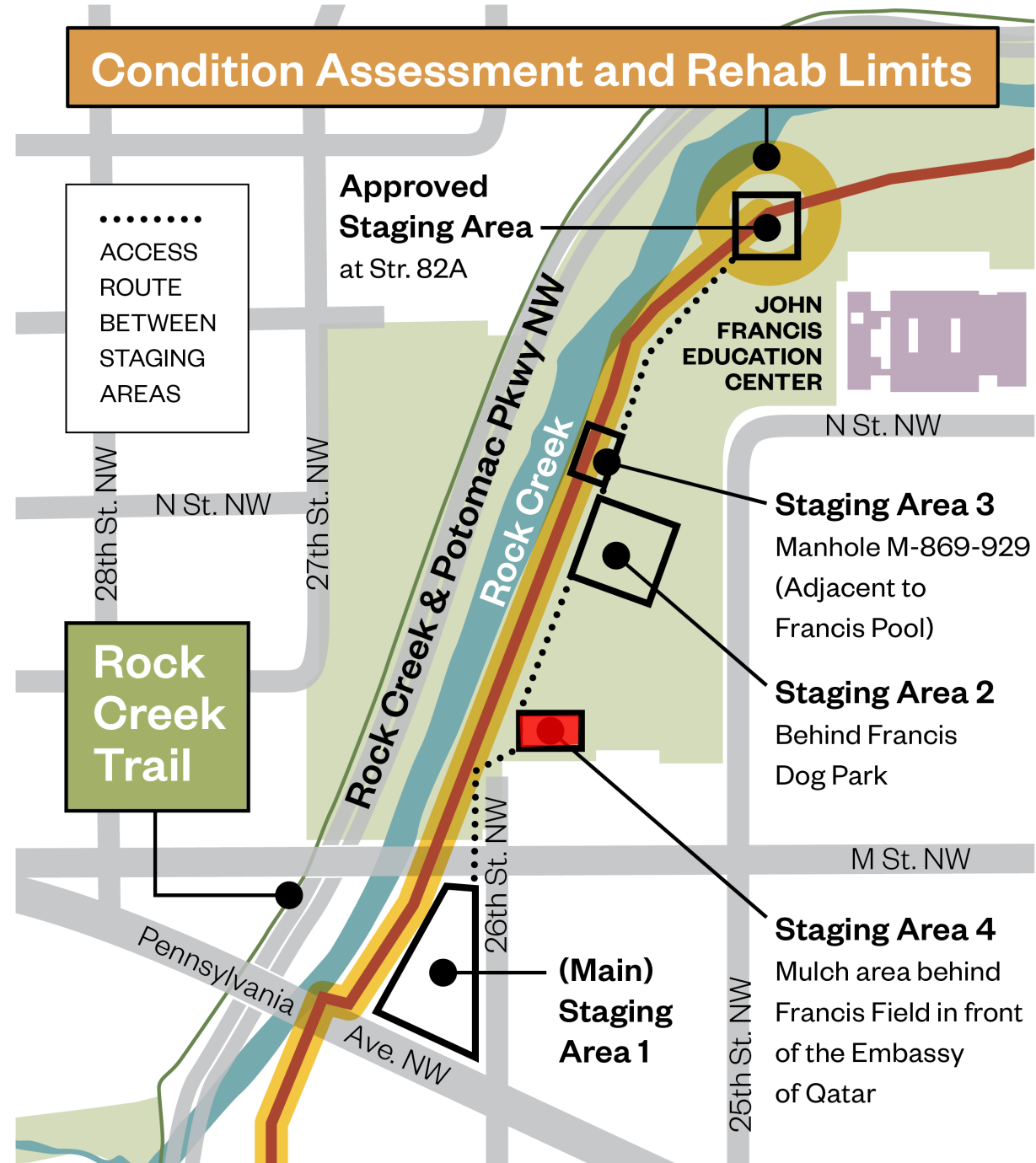
Condition Assessment and Rehab Limits



Secondary Staging Area 4 behind Francis field.



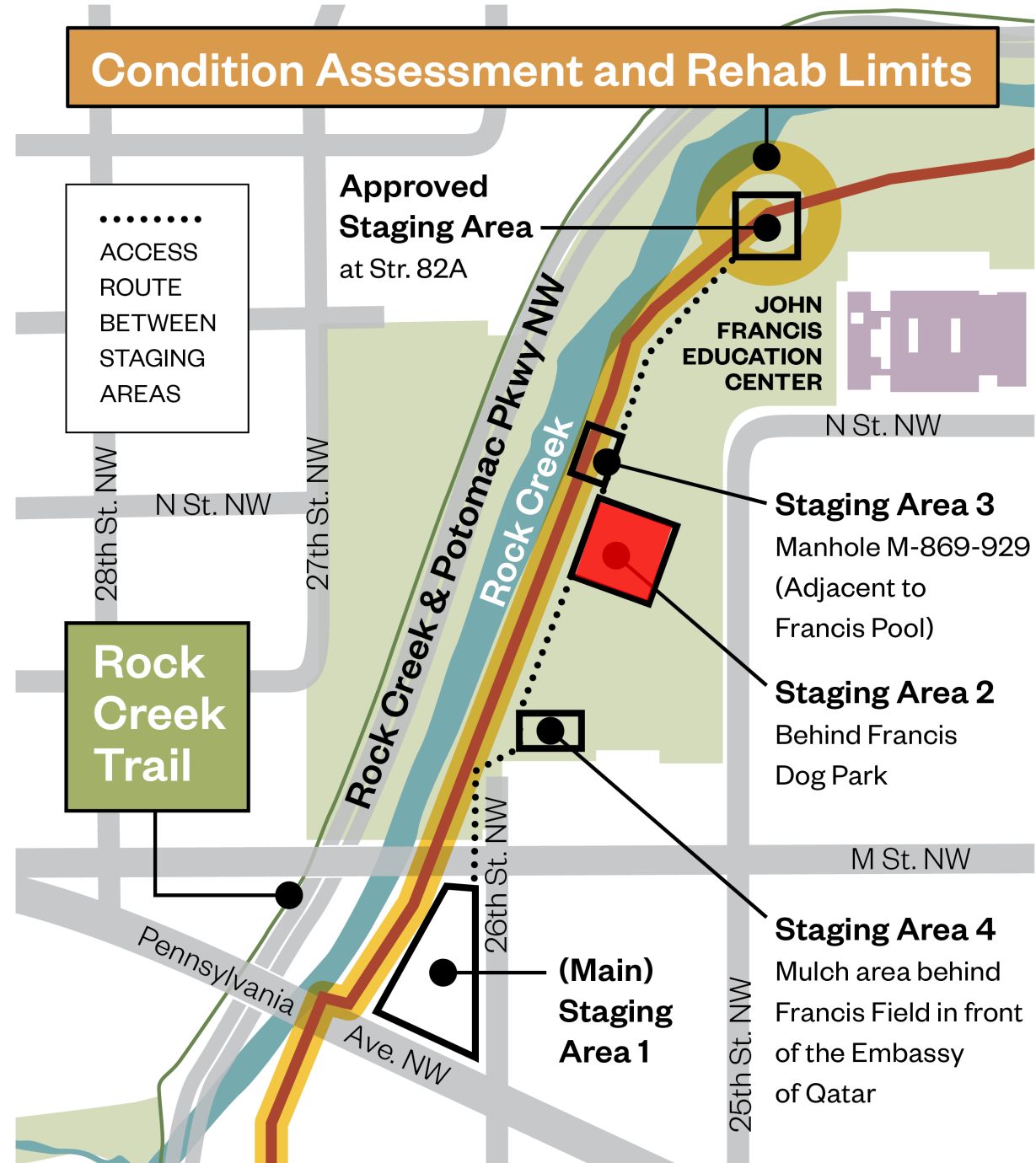
Staging Area behind John Francis Field. Staging area would be on the outside of the fence and be on the mulch/grassy area.

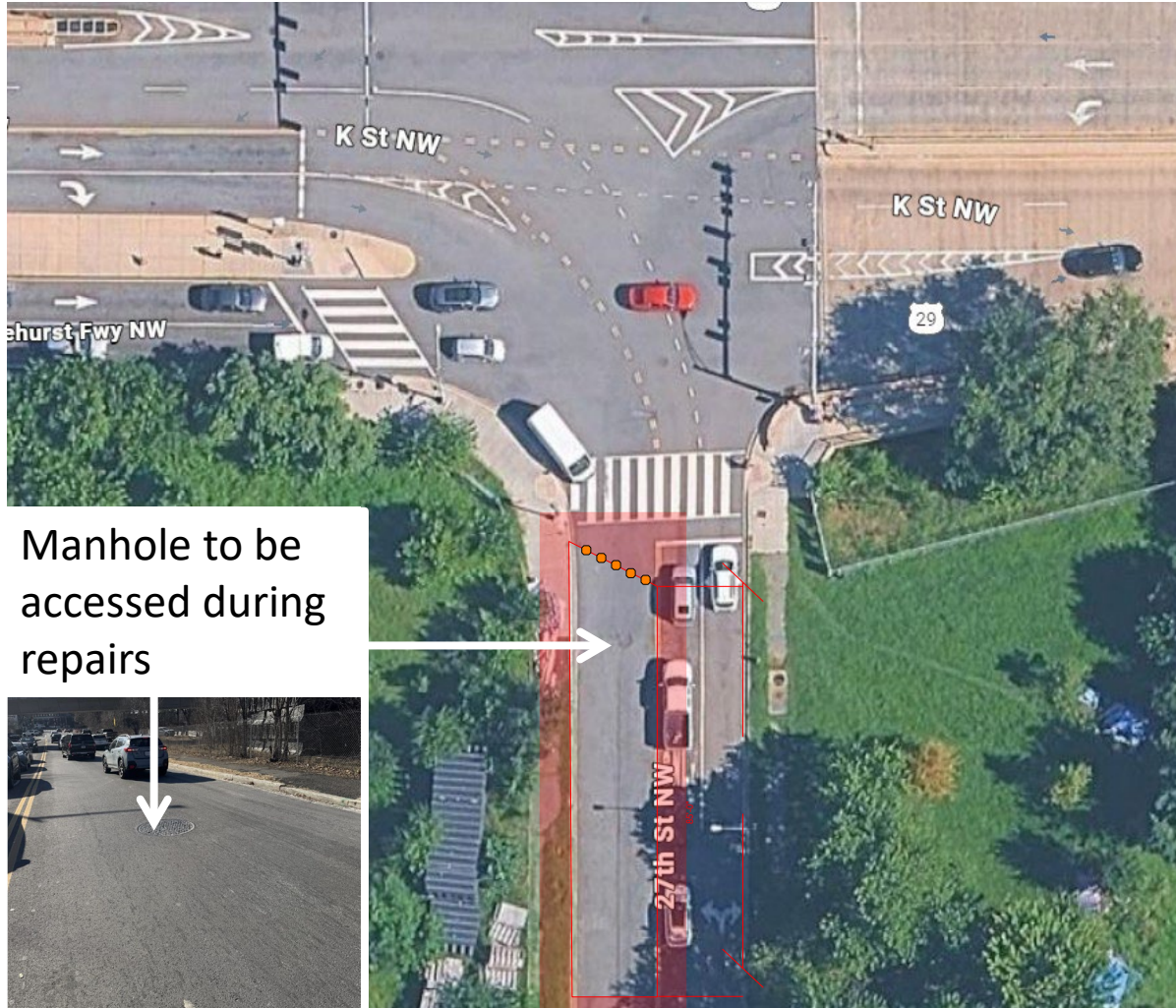
Secondary Staging Area 2

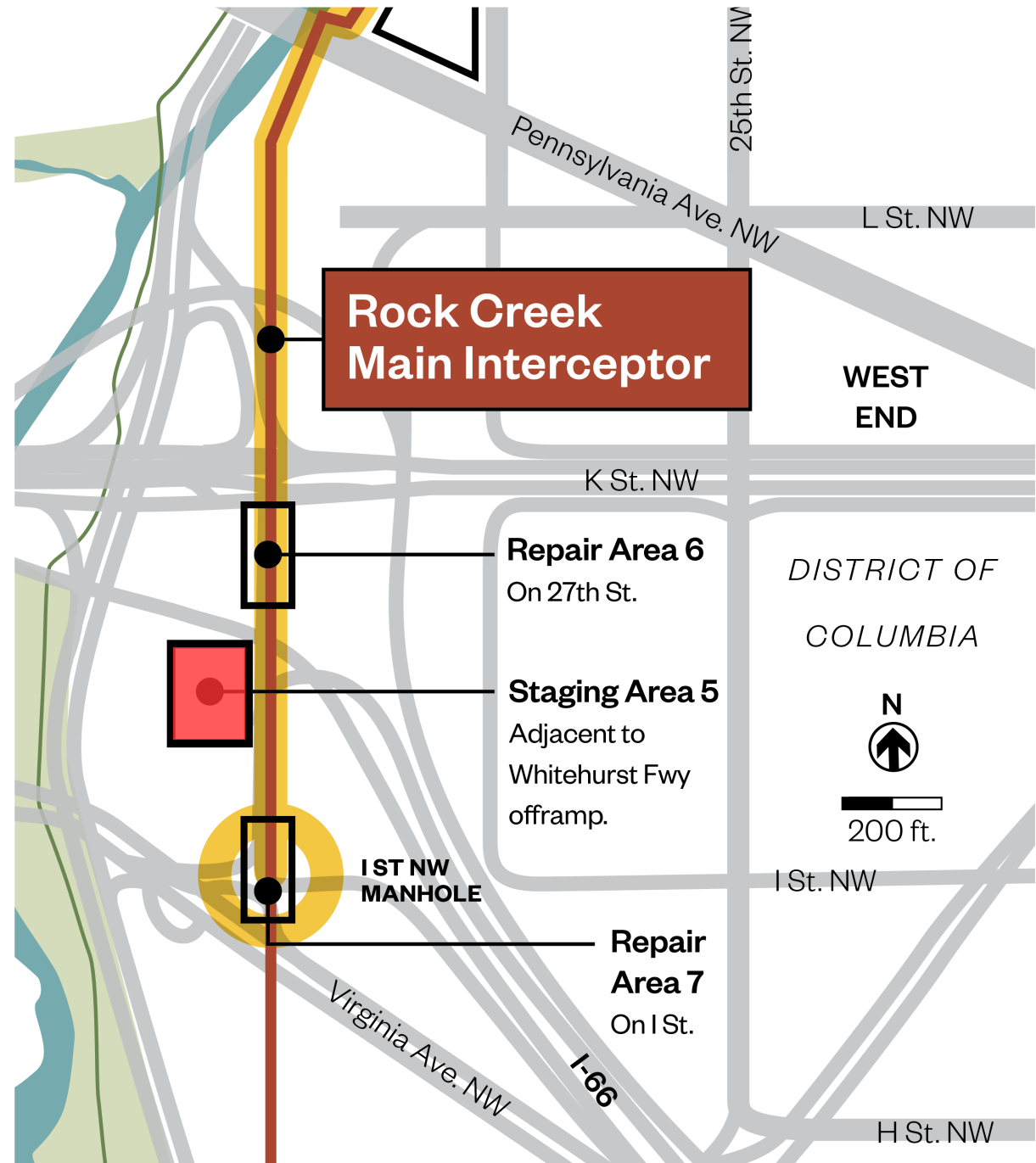
Manhole to be accessed during repairs

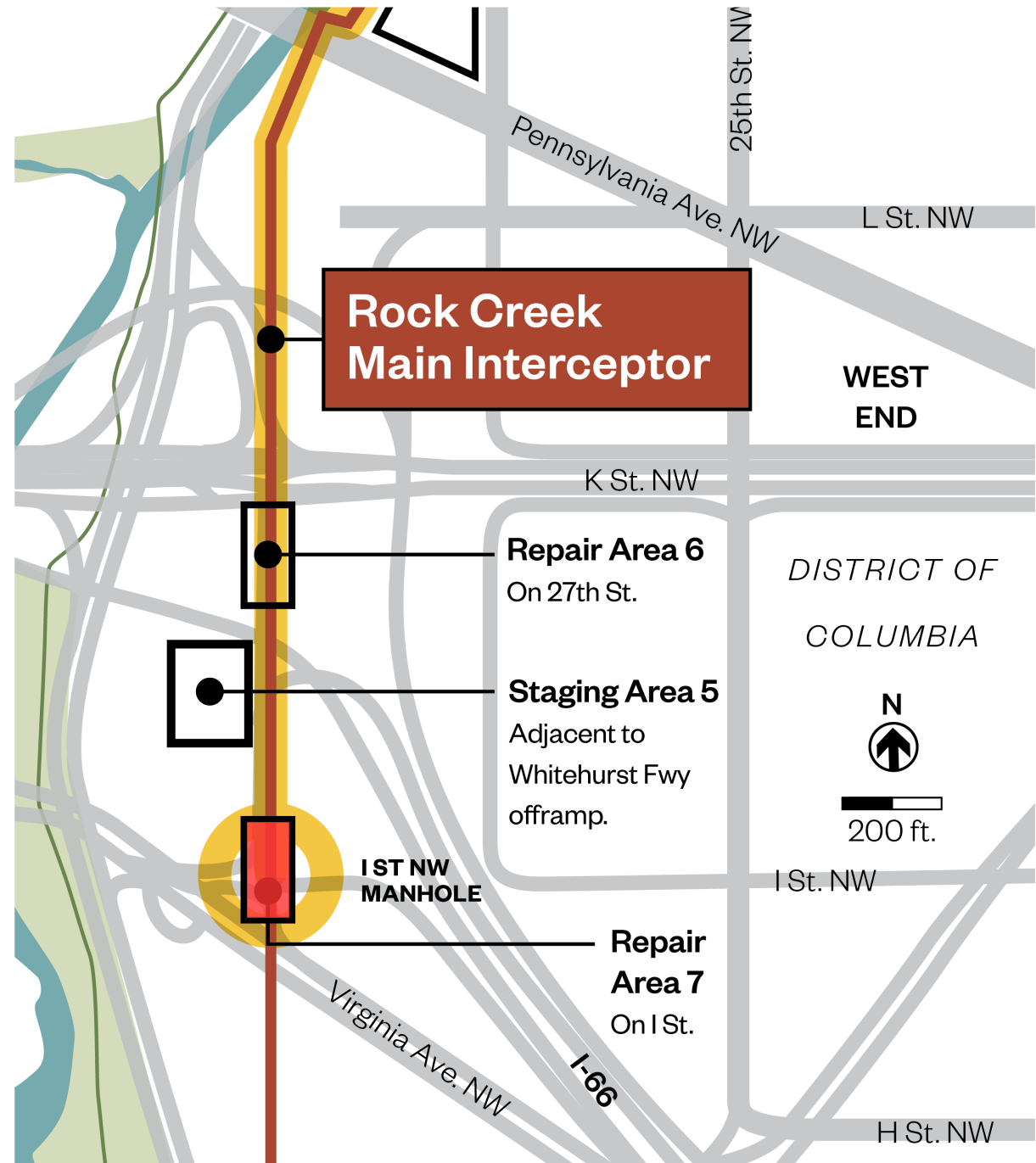
Secondary Staging Area 5 adjacent to "Slot" and next to bridge
