

WHEREAS, all ANC Commissioners take an Oath of Office, affirming that they will faithfully execute the laws of the District of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, Section 14(e)(2) of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975, as amended (D.C. Official Code § 1-309.11(e)(2)) (the "ANC Act"), governs the removal of an ANC officer; and

WHEREAS, Under Section 14(e)(2), the removal of an officer shall be undertaken at a special Commission meeting; and

WHEREAS, such a meeting shall be called if at least one-half of the elected Commissioners request in writing that the Chairperson call one; and

WHEREAS, such a meeting must be convened by the Chairperson within 30 days of that request; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2026, two-thirds of the ANC 2A Commissioners requested in writing that a special meeting be called to consider the removal of the ANC 2A Chairperson; and

WHEREAS, the ANC 2A Chairperson, in violation of the law, refused to convene the special meeting by June 12, 2026; and

WHEREAS, that refusal constituted a violation of the Chairperson's Oath of Office; and

WHEREAS, ANC 2A operates under Bylaws which were approved by the Commission on November 20th, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Article 3, Section 7 of these Bylaws states that Advisory Neighborhood Commissioners shall comply with the Ethics Act and regulations promulgated by the Board of Ethics and Government Accountability (BEGA); and

WHEREAS, those regulations include a Code of Conduct; and

WHEREAS, that Code of Conduct requires adherence to all federal, state, and local laws and regulations;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 2A shall inform BEGA of the Chairperson's violation of DC law and the Code of Conduct, and request that the agency take appropriate disciplinary action.
